

REVISED STRUCTURE OF THE CLINGENDAEL INSTITUTE IN 2012

The Clingendael Institute welcomes the new year in a different set up. As of January 2012, the European Studies, Diplomatic Studies and Security and Conflict Programmes formally no longer exist.

The Institute will continue its work within the framework of two departments: Clingendael Research and Clingendael Academy. The activities of Clingendael Research focus on Europe, security and conflict issues, diplomacy and the changing geopolitical landscape, with particular attention for Asia and the Middle East. Clingendael Academy is responsible for all our courses and training programmes. This transition will gradually take place and will be completed in the course of 2012.

Please note that these organizational changes do not apply to the Clingendael International Energy Programme (CIEP).
