Dr. Peter van Ham is Senior Research Fellow at the Clingendael Institute. He is also Adjunct Professor at the College of Europe in Bruges (Belgium). His research focuses on transnational security, transatlantic relations, the proliferation of weapons of mass destruction, and place branding. He is a member of the editorial board of *Security Dialogue* (Sage). His latest book is entitled *Social Power in International Politics* (Routledge, 2010). He has published in *The National Interest, Foreign Affairs, The Washington Quarterly, NATO Review, Security Dialogue, European Security,*

International Politics and Millennium.



Dr. Remco van de Pas is a medical doctor, specialized in international public health. He has been working in a mental health organization, in primary health care and HIV/AIDS programs within and outside the Netherlands. Remco has been working during the last 5 years for the Wemos foundation and recently joined the health policy unity at the Institute of Tropical Medicine, Antwerp. In his work, he has analyzed the governance of global health institutions, such as the World Health Organization, health equity and international policy coherence for health.



Dr. Louise van Schaik is Coordinator of the knowledge group on Global Issues, Governance & Diplomacy at Clingendael Institute. In her research she has extensively analyzed the EU's performance in multilateral fora, including in the fields of health, climate change and food standards. She has also written on related research areas such as EU external affairs and the Lisbon Treaty, EU development cooperation and trade policy, scarcity of natural resources and sustainable development. Louise has published various policy reports, books, academic

articles and commentaries. She conducted research projects for governments, (international) foundations, the private sector, the European Commission, the Netherlands Environmental Assessment Agency and others. Louise has a Master's degree in Public Administration from Leiden University and a PhD in Political Science from the KU Leuven. Prior to joining Clingendael in 2006, she was a Research Fellow at CEPS, the Brussels-based think tank, for four years.



Dr. Jan Rood is Senior Research Fellow at the Clingendael Institute. He also has a special professorship at Leiden University, where he teaches European integration from a global perspective. His main fields of expertise are European integration, the role of the EU in relation to the multilateral institutions, and EU neighbourhood policy.
